

Carol Birch Since she began telling stories in 1971, audiences have responded to Carol Birch's infectious enthusiasm and artistry. She offers a wealth of stories full of memories worth having. After she tells, adults want her to stay, kids want to know when she'll be back, and colleagues want to talk shop. A third-grader in North Carolina once asked how she knew a story and his friend exclaimed: "She knows that story 'cause she was there!"

In 1998 Carol Birch received the National Storytelling Network's Circle of Excellence Award given to storytellers recognized as master tellers by their peers.



Bil Lepp is an internationally-known storyteller and humorist whose style has been described as a satisfying blend of Bill Cosby and Jeff Foxworthy. A five-time champion of the West Virginia Liars' Contest, his outrageous tall-tales and witty stories have earned the appreciation of listeners of all ages and from all walks of life. Lepp explains that while his stories may not be completely true, they are always honest.

He is an award-winning author and recording artist, and has been featured at venues across the nation. Lepp is the recipient of the Storytelling Circle of Excellence Award.
